Code of conduct for Junior Playing Members

Feathers Junior Badminton Club is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the well being of all of its members. The club believes that it is important that members, coaches administrators and parents/carers associated with the club should at all times show respect and understanding for the safety and welfare of others. Therefore members are encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the club with the Welfare Officer – Phil Hassell.

As a member of Feathers Junior Badminton Club you are expected to abide by the following Junior Code of Conduct.

- ✎ All members must play within the rules and laws of the game and respect officials and their decisions.
- ✎ All members must respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of age, gender, ability, race, cultural background or religious beliefs or sexual identity.
- ✎ Members should keep to agreed timings for training sessions and competitions or inform their coach or appropriate official if they are going to be late.
- ✎ Members should, if selected for a competition or match and is required to withdraw, inform their coach or appropriate official immediately.
- ✎ Members must wear suitable badminton sports clothing for club sessions and competitions, as agreed with the coach or officials of the club.
- ✎ Members must pay any fees for training and events promptly or by the due date.
- ✎ Junior members are not allowed to smoke, consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on the club premises or whilst representing the club. (Junior members who are required to take prescribed medicine must discuss this with the Welfare Officer.)
- ✎ All members are to learn the value and practice good sportsmanship and fair play.
